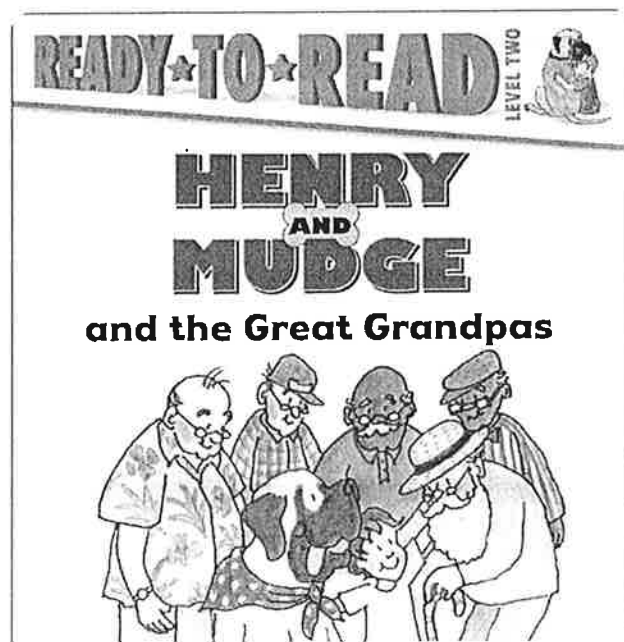

Even though the weather's warm and it's tempting to spend the summer at the beach, it's important that emerging readers practice their literacy skills over the summer.

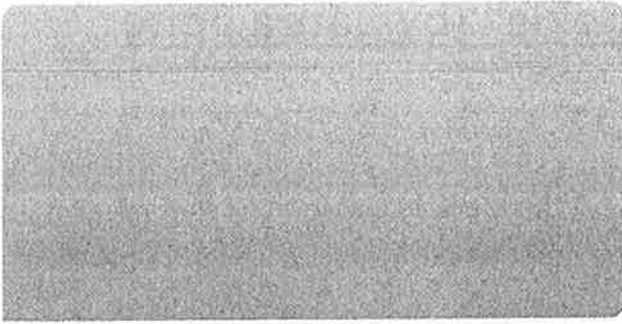
These books can not only help children keep their reading skills in tip-top shape but also provide a great way to spend time together as a family.

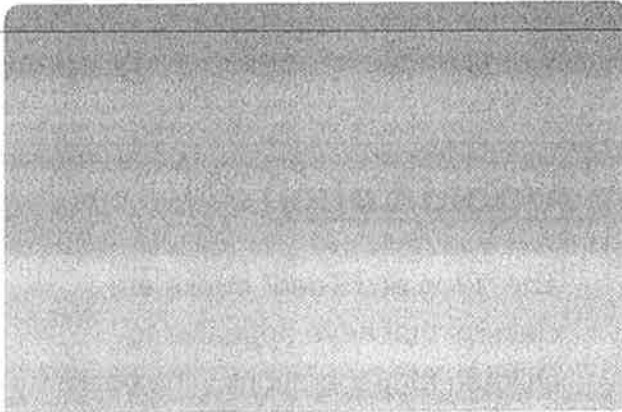
Henry the mouse is uncertain about the first grade at first. However, as he tells his mother about his first day, he realizes that for every bad thing that happened, there was something good as well.

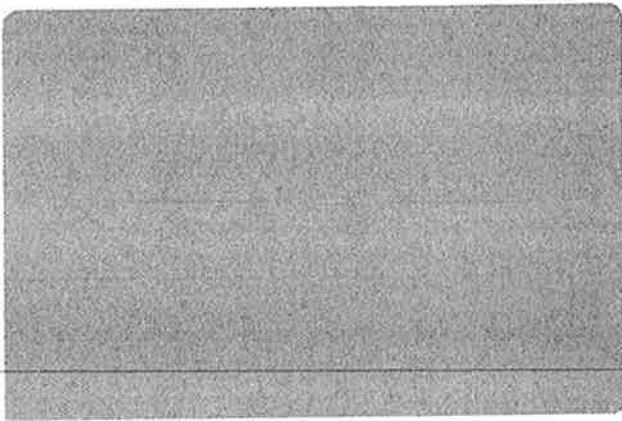
